# <u>Training sessions and start-up events for the residents at the Local Communities of Ancient Olympia Municipality</u>

Within the framework of implementing information and public awareness actions, the NTUA working group in collaboration with the local authorities of the three local communities of the municipality of Ancient Olympia, organized the 1st information campaign for the start-up of the Green Kiosks and the 2nd training seminar for the residents at the local communities implementing the project.

# The purpose of the events was:

 to inform the residents about the launching of the Green Kiosks and the procedure that needs to be followed in order to actively participate in the project.

During these events, which took place in December 2019. leaflets were distributed which provided guidance on the proper separation of the recyclable source and the at waste operation of the recycling system, as well as bags of different colours to help residents separate the according to the four main recycling streams (paper/cardboard, plastic, metal and glass).



Municipal representatives informed and distributed equipment to a total of 495 households at the three local communities.
