





2nd Information Campaign – Questionnaire Results


The questionnaire accompanying the 2nd Small Cyclades information campaign was available and uploaded on the Internet (Municipality website, Facebook account and the project's You Tube account) for the period March-April 2021, supplemented by 16 people. Of them:


- ☐ 100% recycle
- ☐ 100% knew about the Green Kiosks operating in their area
- 87% participate in recycling with the Green Kiosk
- ☐ 72% visit the Green Kiosks every 2-3 days






2nd Information Campaign – Questionnaire Results

- 69% were not satisfied with the waste management system that existed before the introduction of the Green Kiosk
- Out of the 56% of those who weren't satisfied with the Green Kiosk, 89% gave the following reasons:
 - Large accumulation of waste
 - Poor external state of the Kiosk
 - ☐ Better organization and supervision from the operator is required
- ☐ 100% of those who have not participated in using the Green Kiosks, would like to do so in the future


